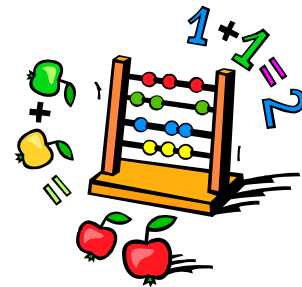

Walking Field Trips Planned!!

We are planning two walking field trips. Our first will be on Thursday, May 20th to Twin Rivers Park. We are planning a play/lunch day that will include all 64 kindergarteners!! We will need 2 parent volunteers from each classroom for this trip. We will also need on morning parent to drive. We would like a car there in case of an emergency. And to transport our AM children's lunch's to the park. That's right, ALL of the children (AM and PM) are asked to pack a COLD lunch that day. Here's the plan: AM will leave the school about 10:30 am and walk to the park. PM should plan on arriving at 11:15 am in at the park. We will all eat lunch together at 11:45 am.
